

FAQ SHEET ABOUT FIYA ATHLETIC EVENTS

Updated as of August 1, 2022

1. WHAT IS FIYA?

FIYA (pronounced FEYE-Yuh) is the acronym for FOUNDATION FOR INTERSCHOLASTIC YOUTH ATHLETICS. Established in August 2011, FIYA is a nonprofit entity providing athletic events for middle and elementary schools in Los Angeles and the surrounding areas.

2. WHAT GRADE LEVELS CAN PARTICIPATE IN FIYA ATHLETIC EVENTS?

FIYA offers three divisions by grade level for competition:

Division 1 is for students in grades 8 and below.

Division 2 is for students in grades 6 and below.

Division 3 is for students in grades 4 and below.

Typically, each division has a girl's component and a boy's component.

No high school student, regardless of his/her age, can play in a FIYA athletic event. Middle school and elementary school students must meet the age eligibility requirements as set forth in ARTICLE III, SECTION 2 of the FIYA Regulation Manual.

3. WHAT ATHLETIC EVENTS DOES FIYA OFFER?

FIYA offers athletic events in two forms: (1) LEAGUE EVENTS and (2) TOURNAMENT EVENTS.

LEAGUE EVENTS occur over an 8 to 10-week period involving a regular season league schedule and playoffs (for qualifying Division 1 teams only).

TOURNAMENT EVENTS can be designated as tournaments, meets or competitions and are generally one day or multiple day events that typically offer an individual competition as well as a team competition.

6. HOW DOES MY SCHOOL REGISTER FOR FIYA LEAGUE EVENTS OR TOURNAMENT EVENTS?

First contact FIYA at INFO@ONFIYA.ORG to ensure that someone from your school is on the FIYA email distribution list. If your school does not already have an athletic director, we recommend that you appoint a school employee as the school's athletic director or coordinator and this individual is the main contact for FIYA. FIYA sends periodic emails to our active email distribution list about upcoming events and important dates.

Second go the REGISTRATION tab of our website and view the information for the league and/or tournament event for which your school is interested in participating. Complete the online registration as it pertains to that sport. Please note for some sports - - cross country and track & field - - the registration is done via a separate platform as described in the information section of such sports.

7. HOW ARE FIYA LEAGUE EVENTS ORGANIZED? WHERE AND WHEN ARE THE GAMES?

First FIYA organizes its league events geographically. That is, we group school teams together based on their physical location in order to minimize travel. Second, based on the number of schools in a geographic area, we attempt to organize the school teams into leagues of similar quality based on our historical knowledge of the teams and any input we receive.

FIYA league events are centralized which means our games occur at a location in the region which hosts multiple games per day. The majority of our league events and tournament events occur on weekdays between the hours of 4 pm and 7 pm start times.

8. HOW MUCH DOES IT COST TO REGISTER FOR FIYA ATHLETIC EVENTS AND WHEN IS THE PAYMENT DUE?

There are two general fees: the first is a **Membership Fee** and the second is the **Registration Fee** for the League Event and/or Tournament Event. When a school registers for a league event or a tournament event for the first time in a particular school year, the school will be charged the one-time Membership Fee at that time.

A. Membership Fee – All participating schools will be charged a one-time membership fee of \$150. The membership fee covers the entire school year. This fee is intended to cover some of the incidental expenses involved when a school team participates in FIYA including, without limitation, coaching, marketing, signage, & banking fees.

B. Registration Fee – This fee depends on whether the sport is a League Event or a Tournament Event.

i. League Event – the cost is \$550 per team with the exception of eSports (which ranges from \$75 to \$150 per eSports team). This covers the entire expense for referees, game operators, facility and administrative fees for a 7 to 9 game regular season plus playoffs for Division 1 qualifiers.

ii. Tournament Event – unless otherwise stated in a sport's registration information, the cost is based per individual and is \$15 per athlete.

Payment for Membership Fee, League Events or Tournament Events can be by credit card and check. Unless a school is notified otherwise, payment is not needed prior to the start of the event; we typically invoice a school for league events *during* the league event season and for tournament events *after* the completion of the entire tournament events.

9. ARE THERE REFUNDS OR DISCOUNTS AVAILABLE WITH RESPECT TO THE MEMBERSHIP OR REGISTRATION FEE?

There is no refund for the annual membership fee, which must be renewed each school year so long as a school continues to participate in our athletic events.

With respect to the registration fee for a league event, if a school team drops from a league event on or before the mandatory coaches meeting for that league, the school will not owe a registration fee. However, after the mandatory coaches meeting, a school dropping from the finalized league schedule still owes the registration fee.

With respect to the registration fee for a tournament event, the school is charged for the number of athletes that it registers for the event regardless of the athlete's participation on the day of the event.

FIYA strives to keep its costs as low as possible. FIYA works with schools to ensure that finances do not prevent their students from participating. In addition, schools that provide gyms and/or fields to host league games are given substantial discounts on the registration fee.

10. WE HAVE A GYM OR A FIELD. CAN WE HAVE HOME GAMES?

Yes, we can schedule games so that your school team has home games as long as the centralized model is adopted. That is, we need to schedule at least two games (back to back) at your school's gym/field. Each FIYA game is no more than 1 hour in length. FIYA substantially discounts a hosting school's registration fee based on the number of hours the school hosts FIYA games.

11. ARE THERE PLAYOFFS? ARE THERE AWARDS GIVEN?

FIYA offers city wide playoffs for all qualifying teams from Division 1 leagues. There are NO playoffs for Division 2 and Division 3 leagues. For Division 1 playoff teams, we typically create two playoffs brackets: Division 1 (usually first place teams and higher skilled teams) and Division 1A (quality teams but slightly lesser skilled).

FIYA awards league championship plaques to all first place teams in all divisions. We also award sportsmanship awards based on league voting. For playoff teams, we award a championship and runner up trophy along with individual medals for the final 2 teams in the playoff brackets. Awards are also given for various tournament event winners.

12. DOES FIYA SUPPLY EQUIPMENT, UNIFORMS OR COACHES?

With a few exceptions, FIYA generally does NOT supply any of these items. However, FIYA can and has provided referrals to obtain practice equipment

and uniforms at a discounted rate as well as aid with schools looking for individuals to coach their teams.
